Mount Baker Council Summer Camp POLICIES and PROCEDURES

Deposits and Fees

A \$100 **non-refundable** deposit is required to reserve space for your troop at summer camp. This deposit assures your troop a campsite at summer camp, but does not guarantee the site selected. Your final site selection will be based upon the number of boys attending summer camp and the capacity of the campsite selected. A minimum of 60% occupation for each campsite must be met. Troops unable to meet this requirement may be asked to share a campsite, or be moved to a smaller site. The Camp Director has the final decision on the campsite selection. We will strive to meet the needs of all troops.

To assure your campsite reservation, a \$50 per Scout non-refundable deposit must be received **in the Scout Office by April 1st**. All camper fees are due in full before June 1st.

Refunds

The refund policy appears in full in the Camp Leaders' Guide. In summary, the \$100 site fee and \$50 per Scout deposit is non-refundable. A portion of remaining fees may be refunded, minus a 25% assessment on the total fee if the Council is notified in writing 1 week prior to arrival at camp. **Any troop arriving at camp with "no show" scouts will forfeit all fees for each "no-show scout"**.

Requests must be made in writing to the Mount Baker Council Service Center, 1715 – 100th PL. SE #B, Everett, WA 98208.

\$100 campsite deposits are **non-refundable**.

April 12 - \$50 per boy deposit is due and **non-refundable**.

June 1 – All remaining fees **due to Council Office to qualify for early fee**.

Any change in your reservation numbers **must be received at the council office prior** to the arriving at camp.

Leadership Requirements

Each troop must have two adult leaders, 24 hours per day, while in camp. Scoutmasters must be at least 21 years of age, assistants at least 18 years of age. All leaders must be registered with the BSA. It is highly recommended that at least one of the adult Scoutmasters be at camp for the entire week. **It is recommended that your SPL attend SPL week** (see Leader's Guide).

Medical Information

Physicals by a medical doctor are required every three years, with parental health statement with parent signature, dated within the last 12 months. Adult leaders are required to have a physical if in camp longer than 72 hours. Adults under 40 need Class I and II Medical Form, and adults 40 and over need Class III Medical Form.

Insurance

Each troop is required to have its own health and accident insurance. Carrier and policy number must be submitted by **April 12** to confirm site reservation. The Council Registrar can help you with information on companies that provide youth group insurance. **All Scouts must be registered members of the BSA.**

Pre-Camp Leaders' Meeting

An orientation for summer camp troop leaders is held before your unit enters camp. The following is covered: camp schedules, new and revised programs, and any special meal arrangements needed for the health and well being of the campers. **Your troop cannot be fully prepared for your week at camp without representation at this meeting.**
