**Please Read and Sign Below**

1. When you arrive at camp, please check in with the Program Ranger or the Camp Ranger.
2. When your stay at camp is over, please check out with the Program Ranger or the Camp Ranger.
3. To protect our trails and roadways, all vehicles must remain in designated parking lot.
4. Firewood is available for your use, please see the Program Ranger or the Camp Ranger.
5. Please check with the Program Ranger or Camp Ranger before you cut any conifers or brush.
6. Any damage to buildings or tent sites will be the responsibility of the Units/Districts and they will be billed for repair or replacement.
7. Safety is vital. Swimming and boating are allowed following the rules of Safe Swim Defense and Safety Afloat. NO swimming in moving water is permitted.
8. Open flame fires must be at least 10 feet away from any structure. (This includes charcoal.)
9. All liquid fuel cans must be locked in vehicles. National policy on the use of liquid fuels must be followed.
10. Pack it in, pack it out. All garbage is to be removed from camp or you will be assessed a garbage removal fee.
11. Please make sure all fires are out before leaving camp. Stir the coals and water them down.
12. Dishwashing should be done in your campsite using a dishpan and hot water. Please don't wash dishes at the water taps.
13. **NO UNAUTHORIZED WEAPONS (INCLUDING PELLET GUNS) OR FIREWORKS OF ANY TYPE ARE ALLOWED IN CAMP.**
14. 5 MPH is the speed limit on all roads.
15. Because of the wildlife present at and near camp, no pets will be allowed.
16. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES and NO SMOKING ARE ALLOWED ON COUNCIL PROPERTY.**
17. Be courteous and "Do A Good Turn" by doing a service project for the camp.
18. Damage and cleaning deposit required on all building rentals. Rental less than \$100, \$50 deposit; rental over \$100, \$100 deposit.
19. **EXEMPTIONS to building/site basic fees:** Events such as Basic Leader Training, Council sponsored work parties, Board approved special events.
